Themes from Breakout Rooms



What went well?

Initial stakeholder meeting created a strong group of people who share the same goals and brought in different partners

Has helped to build collaboration across districts outside of consortiums

Work has aligned with work already going on and so opportunity to create more impact

Have gained lots of data and insight into chosen communities

Using a trusted partner / face has helped to drive community engagement

Consortiums are helping to build connections between people who might not otherwise be connected

Engagement: Surveys built a good foundation knowledge and insight into communities

What hasn't worked so well

Understanding how we work as a consortium - creating equal ownership around delivery - people taking on different roles

Funding sat with a 'lead' has sometimes meant that some partners are less engaged as not receiving payment to do work when lead is.

Timing - summer proved difficult to engage some communities, esp schools and staffing conversations/ momentum due to summer leave

Some consortiums have struggled to find willing community representatives to be part of consortium

Getting to decisions quicker - some meetings have felt repetitive and have lacked pace

Momentum - between meetings and action between has varied

What have we learnt from this?

Recognition that a deeper dive into community via further engagement now needed

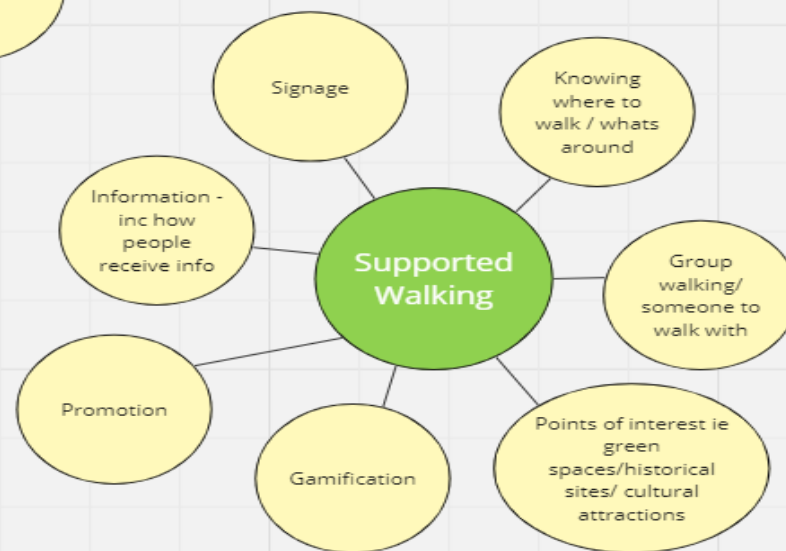
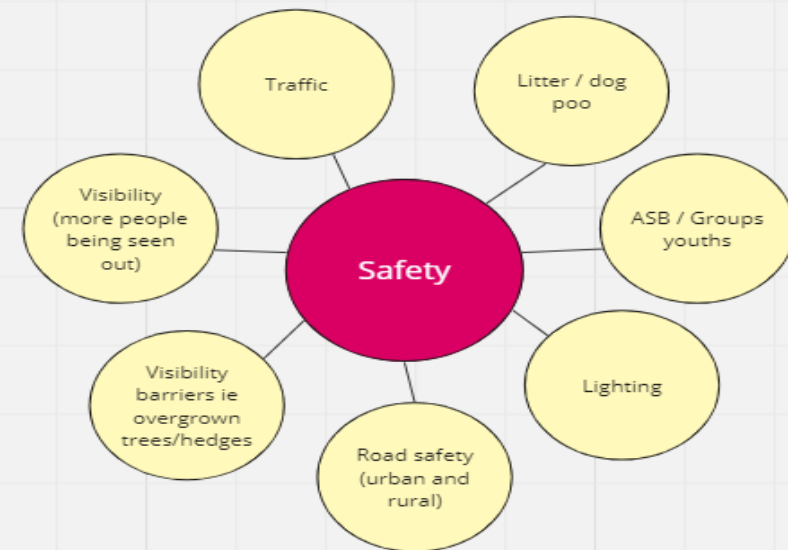
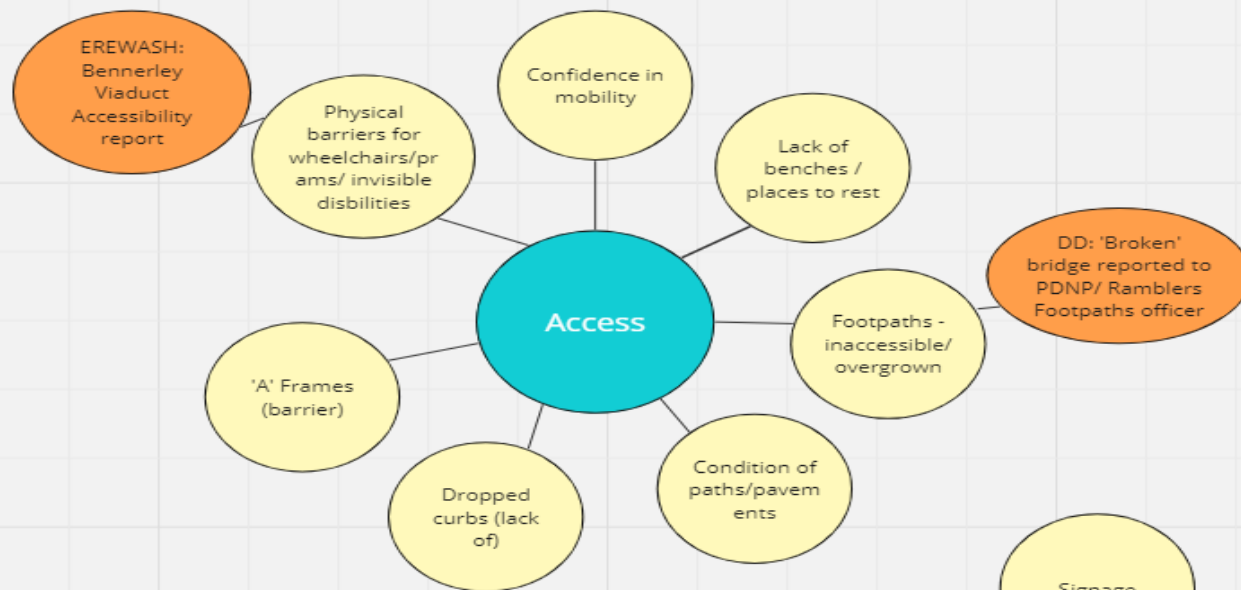
Managing expectations - esp for 20k pilots as to how much can achieve with this funding

Frequency of meetings seems to affect productivity (more frequent meetings felt more reliant in 'lead' to take actions)
