Headline Themes Emerging

- **Initial Development Reflections:**

- Initial timescales: from stakeholder events to Stage 1 applications.
- Terminology
- Extra directional support for consortia from APT/Need for training

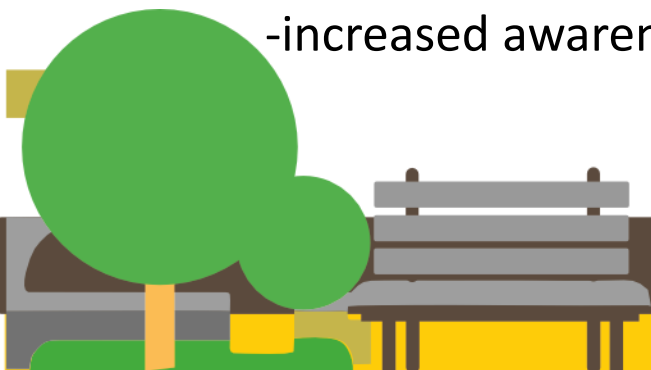
- **Challenges:** external organisational pressures (line managers within organisations)/minimal community voice representation within consortia/traditional focus on learning, confidence

- **Successes:** little-to-no top-down control experienced/trust built upon staff turnover/funding influence on progress

- **Learning Network:**

- to group ANs and CECs/face to face event/working collaboratively in consortium new for many areas
- feeling of competition felt between ANs and CECs, learning network, funding and application processes

- increased awareness & attendance

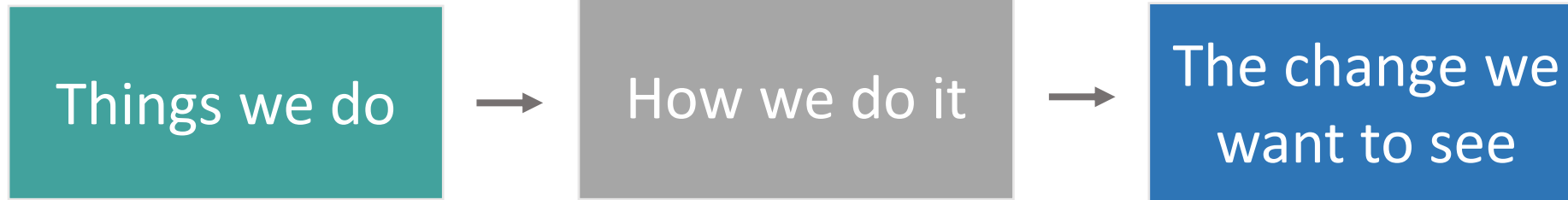


Next Steps

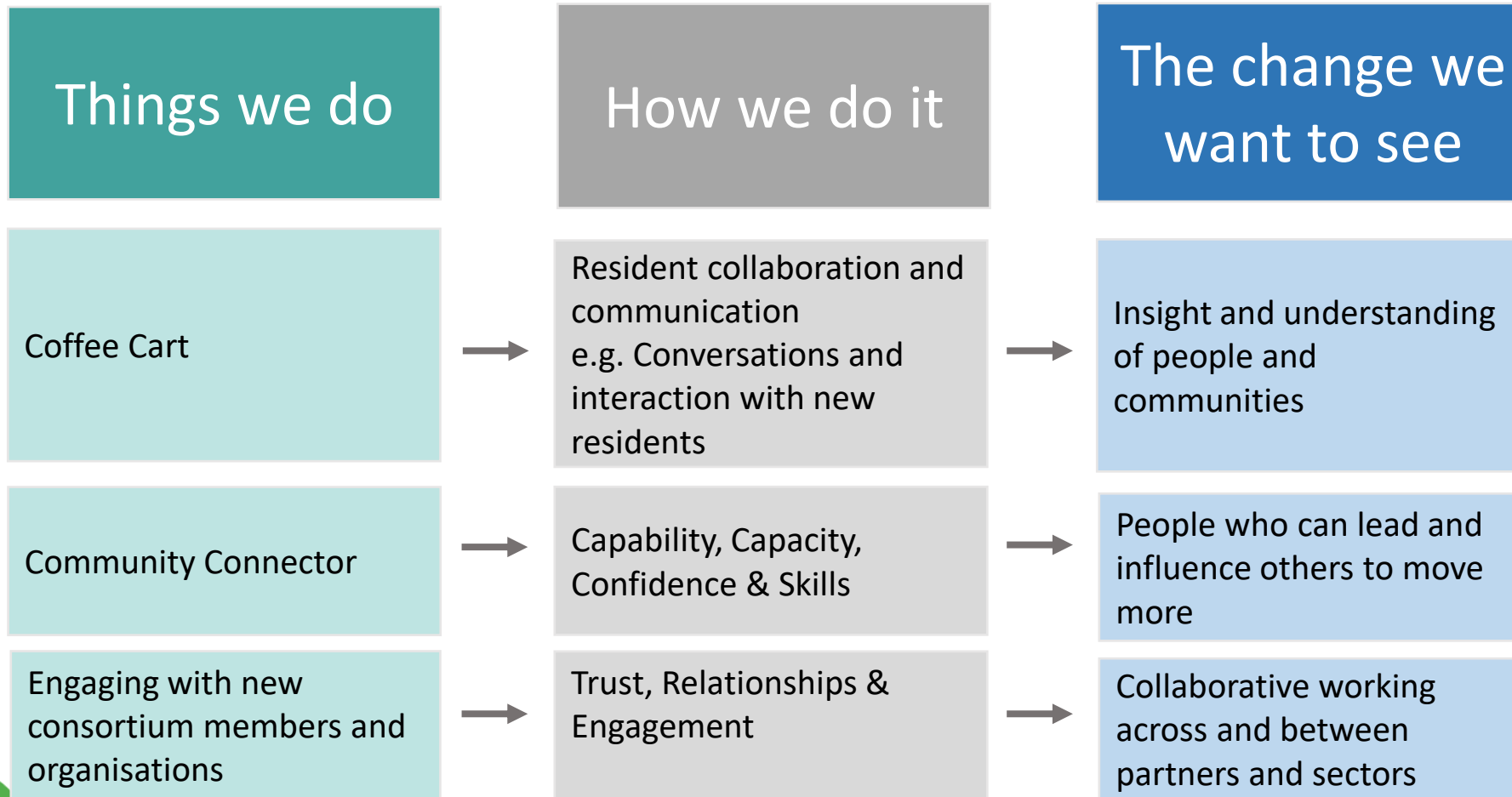
