November	Meeting place	Walk route and distance
Tues 5 th	Shipley Park Visitors Centre	Two Lodges 2.4m Coppice Bridleway, across fields and past Nottingham Lodge and Derby Lodge back to the Visitors Centre.
Tues 12 th	Park in parking space in Bridge Street, Cotmanhay	Lock and Turbine 2.75m Shipley Lock and Erewash Valley Trail via wind turbine. View Bennerley Viaduct and return along Erewash Canal.
Tues 19 th	Shipley Park Visitors Centre.	Mapperley Farm Loop 2.75m Taking Coppice Bridleway past Home Farm, we pass the reservoir to Johns Wood. Return via Bell Lane and Flat Meadow Farm.
Tues 26 th	Park at the Newdigate pub, High Lane East, DE7 6HW.	Newdigate and Nutbrook 3m Take footpaths across the area of "Thatchers Coal", around Straw's Bridge and Manor Floods. Return along the old Nutbrook Canal.
December		
Tues 3 rd	Shipley Park Visitors Centre	Bell and Bridle 3.1m Along bridleways through the Young Peoples' Forest at Mead. Exiting at Bell Lane near Smalley Lodge, we return to the Visitors' Centre via Flat Meadow Farm.
Tues 10 th	At Straw's Bridge Car Park, Ilkeston	Victoria Park and Pewit 2.9m Via Nutbrook Trail and crossing the former Pewit golf course to Victoria Park. We take the path back via golf course and over the former Nutbrook Canal.
Tues 17 th	Shipley Park Visitors Centre	The Two Lanes 3.1m Along the Nutbrook Trail and Field Lane to Shipley Garden Centre for refreshments. Return via Pit Lane and Woodside Bridleway.
Tues 24 th	Shipley Park Visitors Centre	Shipley Hall - 2.5m Coppice Bridleway to Shipley Hall. Circle the Hall Site and return via Beggar's Walk
Tues 31 st	At Straw's Bridge Car Park, Ilkeston	The Spinney 2.9m Via Nutbrook Trail, Ladywood Road and the Spinney. Return via Little Hallam, Rutland Recreation Ground and golf course.
