January	Meeting place	Walk route and distance
Tues 7 <sup>th</sup>	Shipley Park Visitors Centre	Whiteley's Plantation 2.75m  Down to Osborne's Pond and Derby Lodge then along Bell Lane. Entering the area of the Young Persons' Forest, we return along bridleways to the Visitors Centre.
Tues 14 <sup>th</sup>	At Hallam Way, Langley Mill (park in Lidl car park)	Two Canals 3.1m  Along the Nottingham Canals to Shipley Lock, we return to Langley Mill along Erewash Canal.
Tues 21st	Shipley Park Visitors Centre.	Mapperley Farm Loop 2.75m  Taking Coppice Bridleway past Home Farm, we pass the reservoir to Johns Wood. Return via Bell Lane and Flat Meadow Farm.
Tues 28 <sup>th</sup>	Park in Awsworth Road outside Ilkeston FC	Nottingham Canal Nature Reserve 3.0m Through the nature reserve, into Mill Lane and take footbridge over the railway. Return via Erewash Canal.

Tues 4 <sup>th</sup>	Shipley Park Visitors Centre	Shipley Hill 2.5m  Head off to the site of Shipley Hall, we pass the cricket ground, and return along the Nutbrook Trail to the visitors Centre.
Tues 11 <sup>th</sup>	Meet and park at Jacksdale Garden Centre NG16 5HR	Codnor Park Reservoir 3.2m From Garden Centre, along Cromford Canal, circle reservoir and return via canal.
Tues 18 <sup>th</sup>	Park in Pit Lane.	Spider and Pithead 2.97m Through former American Adventure car park, past the Coffee Shop and up to viewing platform and barn. Left at bridge near Coffee Shop, returning to Pit Lane via Coach Road and Heanor Gate Bridleway.
Tues 25 <sup>th</sup>	Shipley Park Visitors Centre	The Two Lanes 3.1m  Along the Nutbrook Trail and Field Lane to Shipley Garden  Centre for refreshments. Return via Pit Lane and Woodside  Bridleway.
