Start time location and times vary, please see below for each week.

- **Tuesday 3rd June – Local Walk**

Meet at Crich Market Place bus stop at 10.30am.

Local walk – approximately 3 miles.

- **Tuesday 10th June – Local Walk With Optional Lunch (pre-booked)**

Meet at Crich Market Place bus stop at 10.30am.

A circular walk followed by optional lunch at the Glebe Centre for £8. Lunch must be booked in advance. Approximately 3 miles.

- **Tuesday 17th June – Ashford-in-the-water**

Meet at Crich Market Place bus stop for the 9.30am (140 bus) to Matlock, (meet at Matlock Railway station). We will then catch the Transpeak bus to Ashford-in-the-Water to view the well dressings and flower festival. Followed by a short walk to Bakewell to catch the Transpeak bus back to Matlock and then the Crich bus (from Matlock). Approximately 3 - 3.5 miles.

- **Tuesday 24th June – Lathkill Dale (and Youlgreave Well Dressing)**

Meet at Crich Market Place bus stop for the 9.30am (140 bus) to Matlock, (meet at Matlock Railway Station). The minibus will pick up at 10.30am from the railway station (the minibus is now fully booked). Please feel free to make your own way and meet us at Alport. We will walk along the river to Lathkill Dale. Refreshments, teacakes and scones will be available to purchase in Youlgreave. We will then view the well dressings and return by minibus to Matlock arriving at the railway station around 3pm. Approximately 4 miles.
